Isla San Lucas

In 2008, Costa Rica declared the island part of the national wildlife preserve.

The island includes a wide variety of wildlife, such as howler monkeys, spiders, snakes, deers and pheasants. There are also at least 8 species of bats on the island. The waters surrounding the island are home to hammerhead sharks, rays, and turtles.

Isla San Lucas was a penal colony until 1991. It had the reputation of being the roughest jail in Costa Rica and its 117 years history is rich with tales of violence. A network of underground prison cells hosted society's undesirables who ran the community, fished, farmed and did domestic chores.

Should you visit the grim bastion, the ghosts of murderers, miscreants, and maltreated innocents will be your guides. A cobbled pathway leads to the main prison building. The chapel has become a bat grotto and only graffiti remains to tell of the horror and hopelessness. There are still guards here, but today their role is to protect the island's resident wildlife from would-be poachers.

On the way to Isla San Lucas, among other beautiful sceneries, we will see Isla Pajaros with hundreds of birds.
